16-051 - Applicability of parking regulations within the Long Island City area

LAST AMENDED 12/5/2024

The provisions of this Chapter shall apply to #accessory# off-street parking facilities, #public parking lots# and #public parking garages#, as set forth in this Section.

- (a) For #accessory# off-street parking facilities, #public parking garages# and #public parking lots# constructed prior to October 25, 1995, or existing #buildings# #developed# without parking, the number of parking spaces required or permitted shall be set forth in Section <u>16-07</u> (Existing Buildings and Off-street Parking Facilities).
- (b) For #accessory# off-street parking facilities, #public parking lots# and #public parking garages# #developed# or #enlarged# after October 25, 1995, the number of parking spaces permitted in a parking facility shall be as set forth in Section <u>16-10</u> (PERMITTED OFF-STREET PARKING IN THE LONG ISLAND CITY AREA). Special rules shall apply to all such #accessory# off-street parking spaces, #public parking lots# and #public parking garages#, as set forth in Section <u>16-20</u>.
- (c) Any increase in the number of off-street parking spaces in an #accessory# off-street parking facility, #public parking lot# or #public parking garage# resulting in a capacity not otherwise allowed under the applicable regulations of Section <u>16-10</u>, shall be permitted only by the City Planning Commission, pursuant to the applicable special permit in Section <u>16-35</u> (Special Permits), inclusive.

16-052 - Applicability of parking regulations for large-scale residential developments within the Long Island City area

The provisions of this Chapter shall not apply to #large-scale residential developments# utilizing Sections $\frac{78-41}{1000}$ (Location of Accessory Parking Spaces) or $\frac{78-42}{10000}$ (Parking Regulations for Commercial and Community Facility Uses).

16-053 - Applicability of Special Purpose Districts within the Long Island City area

In addition to the provisions of this Chapter, further requirements relating to the #Long Island City area# can be found in the following Special Purpose Districts:

- (a) the #Special Long Island City Mixed Use District#, as set forth in Section <u>117-54</u> (Off-street Parking and Loading Regulations); and
- (b) the #Special Southern Hunters Point District#, as set forth in Section <u>125-50</u> (PARKING REGULATIONS), inclusive.
