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138-24 - Height and Setback Regulations in M1 Districts Paired With an R9 or R10 District

LAST AMENDED 12/5/2024

In M1 Districts paired with an R9 or R10 District, the applicable #street wall# location and minimum base height provisions of paragraph (b) of Section <u>138-22</u> (Street Wall Regulations) shall apply, and the applicable maximum height of #buildings or other structures# and setback provisions set forth in Section <u>123-65</u> (Special Height and Setback Regulations in Special Mixed Use Districts with R6 Through R12 District Designations), inclusive, shall apply as modified in this Section.

- In M1 Districts paired with an R9 District, at a height not lower than the minimum base height set forth in Section <u>138-</u> <u>22</u>, nor higher than a maximum base height of 105 feet, a setback shall be provided in accordance with Section <u>23-433</u> (Standard setback regulations). The maximum #building# height shall be 215 feet;
- (b) in M1 Districts paired with an R10 District whose maximum #floor area ratio# is 10.0, at a height not lower than the minimum base height set forth in Section <u>138-22</u>, nor higher than a maximum base height of 155 feet, a setback shall be provided in accordance with Section <u>23-433</u>. The maximum #building# height shall be 275 feet; and
- (c) in M1 Districts paired with an R10 District whose maximum #floor area ratio# is 12.0, at a height not lower than the minimum base height set forth in Section <u>138-22</u>, nor higher than a maximum base height of 155 feet, a setback shall be provided in accordance with Section <u>23-433</u>. The maximum #building# height shall be 295 feet.
